

Elementary Boundary Changes Approved by the School Board 1/12/15

Edgelea to Oakland

If a student is currently enrolled at Edgelea and lives NORTH of TEAL ROAD they will be assigned to Oakland for the 2015-16 school year.

Miami to Oakland

If a student is currently enrolled at Miami and lives NORTH of TEAL ROAD they will be assigned to Oakland for the 2015-16 school year.

Miller to Oakland

If a student is currently enrolled at Miller and lives in the neighborhood bounded by Kossuth Street to the south, 18th Street to the west, and Main Street running diagonally from north to south, they will be assigned to Oakland for the 2015-16 school year.

Earhart to Edgelea

If a student is currently enrolled at Earhart and lives in the neighborhood bounded by Brady Lane on the North, Runyon Drive on the east, the railroad tracks on the south and 18th Street on the west they will be assigned to Edgelea for the 2015-16 school year.

Miami to Glen Acres

If a student is currently enrolled at Miami and lives along and NORTH of Burberry Drive (line drawn extended to the TSC border) they will be assigned to Glen Acres for the 2015-16 school year.

The resulting school enrollments of schools affected by boundary changes are estimated to be:

Oakland	285

Miami	501
Earhart	500
Glen Acres	520
Miller	400

Other Action Related to the Changes

The school board recently approved the appointment of Matt Rhoda to serve as the principal at Oakland Elementary School.
