

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION POLICY

Graduation requirements for Lafayette School Corporation students shall be those minimally established by the State Board of Education as modified by locally adopted standards reflected in the Lafayette School Corporation School Board policy.

The Board shall award a high school equivalency certificate (G.E.D.) to any individual who meets the criteria established by state law.

Special education students who do not qualify for a high school diploma, but complete their I.E.P. programs and are recommended by their case conference committee, may participate in graduation ceremonies and be awarded a Certificate of Completion.

General education students who do not qualify for a high school diploma, but who earn the minimum number of credits towards graduation, may participate in graduation ceremonies and be awarded a Certificate of Credit Completion.
