

Student Vehicles

Parking facilities at Jefferson High School and other school premises may be made available to students upon approval of the school administration. The school corporation, however, reserves the right to establish reasonable rules for the use of such vehicles, including the right to examine the contents of any such vehicles while parked on school premises when an administrator has reasonable suspicion to believe there may have been a violation of state or federal law, or that the contents of such vehicles may include items or elements which are illegal to possess, have been stolen or lost, or present a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of students or staff. Vehicles in violation of parking lot regulations may be towed if the student has been informed at the time the student is given a parking permit or in conjunction with a violation. Repeated violations of parking lot regulations by a student may be addressed through the discipline plan at Jefferson High School or other appropriate discipline plan.

At the direction of the Superintendent, or his designee, the Administration may make use of dogs, law enforcement officials, or appropriate technologies to inspect school premises, including student vehicles.
